HAPPY NEW YEAR! Wait....what? Our seasons seem to blur together as early as Halloween into Thanksgiving melding into the "Christmas Season" as retail is trying to maximize the shopping season. This all happens with good reasons, as this time often is where many businesses make their profits for the year.

In contrast, November 24 is the last Sunday of the church year, and our New Year begins on December 1 with the ADVENT SEASON. This is a time of waiting and watching. What is it that we watch and wait for? We think it is celebrating the birth of Jesus 2000 years ago or wondering when he is coming again. However, the *main focus* is the Advent of God, or Christ's coming in the midst of everyday life — whether in the news or in our personal circumstances; whether frightening, confusing, or mundane. From the Gospel of Matthew, chapter 22, we read, "Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?" Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself." These will be our theme verses for 2020 starting in Advent. Loving God with all our hearts, souls, and minds shapes our Advent prayers. Loving our neighbors will be the theme for Lent, which leads up to Easter.

So immerse yourself fully into the seasons, always waiting and watching for Christ to show up in your life, in our community, and in the world.

OLD BUSINESS

Intern Pastor Program: Pastor Sherri reported that an intern pastor will not be coming to Tri-County Ministry as anticipated.

Discussion of staffing models, staffing costs, and needs of the parish. Primary needs are preaching, visitation, and visibility in the communities. Pastor Sherri will contact Shar Gumke (END Synod office) and the Presbytery for possible assistance in planning. A special meeting of the TCM Council may be scheduled if Shar is available to meet.

Vital Signs: Denny Goetz gave a brief update. The TCM Foundation has agreed to pay the fees for the Vital Signs process.

Scheduling Strategy: Congregational Councils from Trinity, Our Savior's of McHenry, and Grace met on October 27. They propose that for six months of the year (April, May, September-December) each congregation have a lay service once every seven weeks to make the 8:30/10:30 worship times workable. Proposal tabled due to lack of a quorum.

NEW BUSINESS

Tri-County Ministry registered name: Documents of Tri-County Ministry and Tri-County Ministry Foundation are being reviewed. Tri-County Ministry is listed with the ND Secretary of State as "Tri-County Ministry Council." Action is required to correct the registration. Tabled due to lack of a quorum.
